The procurement of organs for transplantation involves the removal of organs from the bodies of the deceased. This removal must comply with legal requirements, including the definition of death and consent

Donation by well-chosen living donors with good health coverage carries negligible risks. This can only be ensured through rigorous selection procedures, careful surgical nephrectomy and donor follow-up to ensure optimal management of undesired consequences.
